

Frequently Asked Questions for Lunch Room

Q- When is Ice Cream Day?

A- Thursdays

Q- What is Ice Cream Club?

A- Ice Cream Club allows you to pay for ice cream for the year through May. You end up getting 2 free ice creams! The price for the club decreases by \$1.00 each week. Email Mrs. Voit to get the current week's amount.

Q- How do I pay for Ice Cream Club?

A- You can send an email to mvoit@sacccs.org giving Mrs. Voit permission to deduct the cost of Ice Cream Club from your child's account, or you can send a check in an envelope with your child's name, home room and "Ice Cream Club" written on it to school.

Q- Can my child use the lunch account system to buy ice cream and snacks?

A- No. **However, if you'd like your child to have permission to take a dollar from their account in order to buy snack etc., simply email Mrs. Voit giving them that permission.**

Q- Can I earn service hours in the Cafeteria?

A- Yes! Each time you volunteer for lunch duty, you earn 2 hours.

Q- What time is Lunch Duty?

A- 11:15-1:15 (Wednesdays are 11:40-1:40)

Q- If it's raining, are parents still needed for Lunch Duty?

A- Even more so! We need parents to help set up the mobile serving station in the school, watch classrooms while the teachers step out, and assist the younger students with their drinks and condiments. After, we need help bringing carts and food back to the Cafeteria.

Q- Can a grandparent or another family member serve lunch duty for me?

A- Yes...**However, they must have Virtus and Fingerprinting through the Archdiocese of Miami**
