Level 3.1


******3rd book is Student choice ******

In addition to the **two mandatory books**, the students must **choose one** from the following series:

The Magic Treehouse by Mary Pope Osborne

Henry and Mudge by Cynthia Rylant

Mr. Putter and Tabby by Cynthia Rylant



Bookmark: Create an **oversized** bookmark with the book title and author's name on the front. The front must also have pictures and be neat, colorful, and creative. On the back, include five sentences on what the book was about

Clothes Hanger Book Report Mobile: Students need a hanger, strings, and paper. The body of the hanger is used to identify the book, and the cards and strings dangling below are filled with key elements of the book, like characters, setting, and a summary.

Character Cards: Make trading cards (baseball cards) for a few characters from the book. On the front side of the card, draw the character. On the backside of the card, make a list of their character traits (ex: loyal, creative) and include a quote or two.

IMPORTANT: ALL work must be completed by the student for full credit. All work is to be neat, colorful and clearly portray what the book is about.

No work may be computer-created.
